## CONGRATULATIONS!!!

We know you are proud of the way your teeth look and feel. You should be, because your help and cooperation have played a very important role in the progress of your treatment.

Your first year of post treatment care and one set of retainers are included in your original contract. After that you will be released from active care. If further adjustments are needed, or the retainer is lost or broken, additional office visit fees will be incurred.

## Please bring your retainer to your <u>Retainer Check</u> appointments Follow these instructions for the care and maintenance of your retainers:

## ORTHODONTIC CLEAR RETAINER INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Your new retainers are to be worn every night while you sleep. It is very important that you wear them each night for a minimum of 10-12 hours. This will help to ensure that you will not have any movement of your teeth.
- Dr. Lepetich has provided a retainer case to store your retainers when they are out of your mouth. Retainers are easily lost, damaged, or broken if not placed in the case. If you have pets, <u>always</u> keep retainers in the case when they are not in your mouth. It is also recommended that you place the case into a drawer as pets can also chew through the case.
- Your retainers need to be cleaned each morning after you remove them from your mouth. Hold the retainers in the palm of your hand and gently brush with toothpaste and <u>cold</u> water. (Do not use warm or hot water)
  We also recommend you clean your retainers daily (or at least 3-4 times per week) using a Denture Cleaner. Follow the instructions on the box for the length of time. Make sure the solution is room temperature prior to soaking your retainers.
- 4. Never expose your retainer to heat. This can change the shape of your retainer and it may not fit properly.
- 5. Your Orthodontic Assistant will demonstrate the proper way to insert and remove your retainers. (Remember to remove retainer by loosening it off the back teeth on either side and do not pull on the retainer in the front of the mouth. Doing so may cause the retainer to tear).

If your retainers become broken or lost call the office immediately. When you are not wearing your retainers at night your teeth can shift and change position quickly! Be very careful!
